

FIVE-INCH TRADES

Directions:

Cut 112 accurate five-inch squares from two yards of the same good quality 100% cotton fabric.

Remove all selvages, starch, iron and fold fabric wrong sides together before cutting. Cut 14 five-inch strips, then 8 five-inch squares from each strip. Stack them in pairs, off-setting each pair by 45 degrees.

Place them in a gallon-sized zip-lock bag clearly marked with your name, phone number and AM or PM.

You may turn them in at either meeting and you may trade more than one set of squares.

The packets of squares will be returned to you at the next meeting along with a suggested pattern for their use.
